SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC seeking quashing of FIR No.865 dated 29.12.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983, at Police Station Sector 32-33 Karnal, District Karnal and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).
2. In deference to order dated 08.05.2023, report has been received from the trial Court and its relevant extract is as under:

1	As per the statement of investigating officer, there is only one person namely Jaswinder Singh arrayed as accused in the present FIR.
2.	No accused has been declared proclaimed offender.
3.	Compromise entered between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.
4.	Accused is not involved in any other case.

5.	Challan has not been received so far in the court in the present case.
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3. Keeping in view the above settlement, report of the Trial Court and the judgments of Supreme Court in *B.S. Joshi and others Versus State of Haryana and another (2003) 2 RCR (Criminal) 888* and *Narinder Singh Versus State of Punjab (2014) 6 SCC 466* this Court is of the opinion that keeping the criminal proceedings alive would not serve any purpose and setting them aside would enable the parties to lead a peaceful and harmonious life.
4. Accordingly, petition is allowed. FIR No.865 dated 29.12.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983, at Police Station Sector 32-33 Karnal, District Karnal, is quashed **qua the petitioner**.
