This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents no.4 and 5 who had illegally detained the original record of the Gram Panchayat village Kalra.

2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Block Adampur, District Jalandhar, in pursuance of representation dated 27.04.2023 (Annexure P-2) has directed the Panchayat Secretary to return the original record on 28.04.2023 and assures the Court that the record would be returned to the petitioner within a period of one week from today.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the statement made by learned State counsel satisfies the claim of the petitioner

and the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but the State counsel would be bound by the statement made before this Court.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. The State would be bound by the statement made before this Court.
