Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.81 dated 11.7.2021 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 469, 470, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station City-1, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner was not signatory to the alleged agreement to sell and further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of previous order of interim bail.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhinder Singh submits that indeed, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 30.5.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
