The instant writ petition had been filed for seeking setting aside of order dated 01.02.2017 (Annexure P-3) and order dated 30.06.2017 (Annexure P-4), whereby the application of the petitioner for grant of electricity connection had been declined by the respondents No.2 and 3 on the premise that the area fell within dark zone.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the respondent-Distribution Licensee has since notified a Sales Circular No.D-36/2021 whereunder the electricity connections can be released.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Disposed of as not pressed.

In the event, the petitioner approaches the respondent-Authorities for revival of his claim in terms of Sales Circular No.D-36/2021, the same shall be considered by the Distribution Licensee in accordance with law.
