JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of impugned order dated 31.03.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2 whereby petitioner has been transferred from Chandigarh to NFL Nangal.

2. On 05.05.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel inter alia contends that the petitioner was appointed as Cook on compassionate ground after loss of her husband, who was serving as Constable and is aggrieved against the transfer order dated 31.03.2023 (Annexure P-1) whereby she has been transferred from Chandigarh to Nangal. Learned counsel refers to the guidelines dated 25.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) to contend that the ordinary tenure of three years at a station can be relaxed, in case the child of the employee is pursuing the studies either in Class 10th or 12th. He refers to the certificate dated

22.03.2023 (Annexure P-5) to contend that petitioner's daughter is a student of Class 12th, but her representation against the transfer order has not been considered.

Notice of motion for 10.07.2023.

In the meanwhile, operation of the impugned order dated 31.03.2023 (Annexure P-1) qua the petitioner shall remain stayed."

3. Ms. Anita Balyan, learned counsel for the respondents-Union of India, at the outset, produced copy of order dated 04.07.2023 passed by respondent-authority. The same is taken on record and Registry is directed to tag at appropriate place.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that request of the petitioner has been considered by the competent authority and vide order dated 04.07.2023 passed by the respondent-authority, transfer of the petitioner has been deferred till 31.03.2024.

5. In view of order dated 04.07.2023 passed by respondent-authority, the grouse of the petitioner stands redressed, thus, present petition has rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
