Application is allowed and Annexures P-2 and P-3 are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

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1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members as they apprehend imminent threat at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had solemnized the marriage on 02.09.2019 with Robin Kumar against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 9 and now, they are threatening the petitioner and her husband. He further submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 16.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) to the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, but no action has been taken till date.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Kumar, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.
6. Without expressing anything on the merits, the present petition stands disposed off and respondent No.2 – Superintendent of Police, Kaithal is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.
7. This order shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the parties. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.
8. With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
