VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to modify impugned provisional Ph.D. degree certificates (Annexures P-9 to P-16) issued to the petitioners No.1 to 8, respectively, without mentioning the name of their subjects, with a further prayer of issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue Ph.D. degree certificates to petitioners by mentioning names of subject of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have given the representations (Annexures P-6 to P-8) to the respondent authorities and have prayed that they would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the competent authority to consider the

representation dated 08.02.20223 (Annexure P-6) as expeditiously as possible and in case there is merits in the plea raised by the petitioners, then, the necessary action in accordance with law be taken by the competent authority as expeditiously as possible.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has submitted that the competent authority would consider the representation dated 08.02.20223 (Annexure P-6) as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present civil writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Competent Authority to consider the representation dated 08.02.2023 (P-6) in accordance with law and in case the competent authority is of the opinion that there is merit in the plea raised by the petitioners, then, to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
