Having married against the wishes of their family members, petitioners, who claimed to be major, are facing threat to their life and liberty from private respondent No.5 and so by way of this petition, they seek direction of respondent Nos.2 to 3 to protect their life.

Petition is accompanied by copy of Matriculation Certificates and Aadhaar Cards (Annexures P-1-P-4) to show that both the petitioners are major. A copy of marriage certificate (Annexure P-5) and marriage photographs (Annexure P-6) are also placed on record. They also placed on record the copy of application dated 02.05.2023 (Annexure P-7), which was moved to respondent Nos.2 and 3.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.

Mr. R.S. Khaira, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3- State.

Without commenting on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners, respondent Nos.2 and 3 are hereby directed to provide necessary protection to the petitioners after assessing threat perception to their life.
