Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record copy of an order dated 20.12.2023 passed by learned JMIC, Amritsar revealing that petitioner has since surrendered before the Trial Court concerned.

Learned counsel further contends that petitioner was declared proclaimed person vide order dated 26.10.2016 (Annexure P-4).

Learned State counsel informs that pursuant to that order dated 26.10.2016, FIR No.232 dated 04.09.2021 under Section 174-A of the IPC was registered at Police Station Division No.D, Amritsar in which arrest of the petitioner is yet to be made. Learned counsel for the petitioner has made a statement so as to withdraw this petition with liberty to seek quashing of the proclaimed person order and the consequent proceedings arising from the FIR u/s 174A IPC.

In view of the aforesaid statement, present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as aforesaid.
