1. Prayer in the present petition filed under section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') is for setting aside order dated 03.03.2023 (Annexure P-23) passed by Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sardulgarh, vide which the bail of the present petitioner was cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued to procure his presence.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has regularly been appearing before the trial Court. Reference has been made to the interlocutory orders (Annexure P-3 to P-22). He submits that the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court on 03.03.2023 on account of some work as the petitioner is a labourer and the absence was not intentional. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court regularly but apprehends that in view of the order dated 03.03.2023, he may be apprehended and put behind the bars.

3. I have considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the petitioner had been regularly appearing before the trial Court, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and files an application for bail, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.
