The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to provide/furnish the cyber cell report in a time bound manner and as per Enquiry Report (Annexure P-9) with a further prayer to get the complaints dated 04.03.2022 and 21.04.2022 (Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively) investigated through independent agency.

Reply on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed wherein it has been stated that pursuant to the enquiry into the complaint, the recommendation was made for registration of FIR and consequently, an FIR No.3 dated 21.07.2022 has been registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 66-C and 66-D of the I.T. Act at Police Station Cyber Crime, Panipat and the investigation is stated to be pending and the learned State Counsel has stated that after considering the grievance(s) of the respective parties, the investigation shall be concluded as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the stand taken by the respondent-State, learned counsel for the petition contends that the present petition has become infructuous.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
