Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the action of the respondents, vide which the petitioner has not been called for interview for the post of Deputy Ranger in General Category despite the fact that the petitioner has scored more marks than the last candidate called for interview.

In compliance of the order passed by this Court, result of the petitioner has been produced in a sealed cover, which is ordered to be opened. Result of the petitioner is taken on record as Mark-'A'. Petitioner has secured 168 marks, whereas, last selected candidate in his category has secured 189 marks.

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
