AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition has been filed for issuance of appropriate directions/order to the official respondents for conducting fair and impartial investigation in FIR No. 120, dated 6th May, 2017, under Sections 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Tripuri Town, District Patiala.

2. *In spite* of two pass overs, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tajinder Singh submits that challan was presented, the trial is now at fag end, only one prosecution witness remains to be examined.

4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are called for, the petition is disposed of.
