1. This is the second petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.203 dated 04.05.2022, registered under Sections 420, 406 and 506 IPC, at Police Station Nagaingarh, District Ambala.

2. On 25.04.2023, this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-
