Learned MACT, Hoshiarpur vide its award dated 07.01.2002 awarded a compensation of Rs.1,61,000/- in FAO-2682-2002 and Rs.2,49,800 in FAO-2683-2002 respectively to the claimant-appellants along with interest @ 7% per annum from the date of filing of the claim petition till realization of the amount.

These appeals have been filed by the claimants-appellants against the impugned award seeking enhancement of compensation.

The present appeals have been referred to this Forum for settlement.

On the request of learned counsel for the appellants notices were issued to the appellants to appear in person before this Forum for the purpose of settlement as he had not been able to contact the appellants. The report has been received that the notices issued to the appellants have not been received back served or otherwise. The matter was again adjourned to await the service of the appellants, which has been received back with the report of incomplete address. Learned counsel for the appellants states that in the absence of the appellants, he is not in a position to settle the matter and requests that the case be consigned to the record room with liberty to reive the same by filing an application before the appropriate Forum if such necessity arises.

In this backdrop of facts, these case are now consigned to the record room with liberty to the party to revive the same by filing an appropriate application before the appropriate Forum if such Necessity arises.
