1. This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned action of respondents No.1 and 2 in detaining the petitioner from appearing in the 6th Semester of BBA Course on the ground of shortage of lectures as well as securing low marks in the local middle semester exams, with a further prayer to issue roll number to the petitioner for supplementary examination of 4th Semester of BBA Course.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has given a detailed representation to respondent No.2, but however, a copy of the same had not been retained by her and has thus prayed that the present writ petition be treated as a representation and respondent No.2 be directed to consider the same and in case, respondent No.2 finds merit in the same, then, the necessary relief in accordance

with law be granted to the petitioner as expeditiously as possible.

3. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the present writ petition as a representation and after considering the averments made in the same, in case, respondent No.2 finds merit in the pleas raised by the petitioner, then, necessary relief in accordance with law be granted to the petitioner within a period of five days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order alongwith a copy of writ petition, which would be submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.2-College.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.2 would consider and decide the matter independently, in accordance with law.
