1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short Cr.P.C.) is for setting aside the order dated 21.05.2015 (Annexure P-8) vide which the application for release of vehicle on Superdari was dismissed. Challenge has also been laid to the order dated 23.09.2015 (Annexure P-10) vide which the revision petition filed against the order dated 21.05.2015 was dismissed.

2. On 30.09.2016, learned counsel for the petitioner was directed to place on record the form Nos.20 and 21 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. On 07.02.2018, learned counsel for the petitioner had prayed for time to comply with the order dated 30.09.2016. On the last date of hearing, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Today also no one has appeared despite the case having been called repeatedly.

Since the order dated 30.09.2016 passed by this Court has not been complied with and further since no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
