The petitioner prays for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order Annexure P-11 passed by the Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, on 25.11.2020. In substance, he prays for a direction to the respondents to consider his case for promotion to Master cadre as English Master from the date on which his junior was promoted.

The learned counsel representing the respondent-State has entered appearance pursuant to supply of an advance copy of the writ petition and submits that the petitioner's name was considered along with the other candidates, however, the petitioner failed to secure more marks than the last selected candidate i.e. respondent no.5. However, he admits that this fact is not recorded in the order dated 25.11.2020.

Once a competent authority is passing an order to dispose of the petitioner's representation in compliance of the order passed by this court, it is expected that the Director Public Instructions (SE) shall disclose all the reasons for rejecting the petitioner's claim.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of with the directions to the Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, to pass a fresh order, after granting an opportunity of hearing to all concerned, who are likely to be affected by the order, within a period of 2 months, from today., positively.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
