Petitioner is seeking to quash report No.21 dated 06.02.2019 as well as kalandra No.231 dated 06.02.2019 whereby the proceedings under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C have been initiated against him and also for protection as he is apprehending danger to his life and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sukhjit Singh Virk, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sri Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner rather he is threatening respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

In terms of order dated 15.11.2022, learned counsel for the petitioner had sought permission to withdrawn his power of attorney and was permitted to do so. The notice issued to the petitioner has been received with the report that he is not residing at the given address. Notice has been issued as per

the address as mentioned in the petition.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
