Prayer in this application is for placing on record the order dated 05.03.2018 (Annexure P-3), letter dated 14/15.03.2018 (Annexure P-4) and receipt dated 16.03.2018 (Annexure P-5)

Heard. For the reasons, mentioned in the application, the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. Documents Annexures P-3 to P-5 are taken on record.

Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondent to compound the offence and to accept the principal amount alongwith reasonable compensation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the matter has been settled with the respondent and the entire amount due to be paid to the respondents has already been paid alongwith compound interest as demanded by the respondent. A communication dated 02/03.09.2020 has been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the said compromise having been arrived at between the parties, an application for compounding the offences shall be moved before the Appellate Court where the appeals against conviction are pending. He submits that the present petition be, therefore, disposed of in view of the aforesaid circumstances.

In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. If an application for compounding the offences is moved before the Appellate Court, the same be decided in accordance with law.

The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
