The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits such as gratuity, leave encashment and pension as due to the petitioner with interest @ 18 % per annum from the date the amount became due till payment.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the present matter is squarely covered by **CWP No.15780 of 2008** titled as “**Sudershan Kumar Vs. State of Punjab & others**” decided on 20.09.2023 wherein writ petition was dismissed with liberty to the petitioners to file an appeal before the Tribunal by raising all the grounds.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in same terms as in *CWP No.15780 of 2008* titled as “*Sudershan Kumar Vs. State of Punjab & others*” and liberty is granted to the petitioners to file an appeal before the Education Tribunal, Punjab and to raise all the grounds before the Tribunal.

All pending miscellaneous applications, also stands disposed of.
