The prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C is for quashing of complaint bearing Criminal Complaint No.792/2018 dated 02.11.2018 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 406, 417, 420, 34, 120-B IPC pending in the Court of JMIC, Ludhiana and the summoning order dated 01.02.2019 (Annexure P-6) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that during the course of the present proceedings, a compromise has been effected between the parties.

The learned counsel for the respondent-complainant accepts the said fact and contends that he has received the entire amount of Rs.4,25,000/-.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the Criminal Complaint No.792/2018 dated 02.11.2018 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 406, 417, 420, 34, 120-B IPC pending in the

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Court of JMIC, Ludhiana, the summoning order dated 01.02.2019 (Annexure P-6) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom stands quashed on the basis of the compromise between the parties.

Petition stands disposed of.
