1. Power of attorney on behalf of respondent has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

2. Vide letter No.445 dated 15.09.2023, learned Additional Principal Judge Family Court, Camp Court at Ajnala has informed this Court through Registrar General (Punjab and Haryana High Court at Chandigarh), that the petition filed by respondent-husband, under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act has already been dismissed in default vide order dated 18.08.2023 due to the non-appearance of the parties. The said factum has been confirmed by both the counsel present before this Court.

3. In view of the fact that the divorce petition has already been disposed of by learned trial Court, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

5. However, petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present petition, in case petition filed by respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act before learned trial Court is revived.
