The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 101 dated 24.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 22, 29 and 25 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Special Task Force, STF Wing Mohali (P.S. Bhawanigarh).

Learned State counsel has submitted that even though the petitioner has averred that there are only two cases that have been registered against him, however, there are as many as five criminal cases that were registered against the petitioner viz. FIR No. 12 dated 12.01.2020, under Section 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Samana; FIR No.69 dated 10.06.2020, under Section 22 and 25 of the NDPS Act at Police Station, Phase 4, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali; FIR

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No. 313 dated 16.11.2020, under Section 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act, Police Station, Bhawanigarh, FIR No. 315 dated 08.10.2022, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act read with Section 52 (A) Prison At at Police Station Tripuri and FIR No. 30 dated 28.01.2023 under Section 52-A, 42 of the Prison Act, and Section 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Tripuri apart from FIR No. 101 dated 24.08.2020.

On confronted with the same, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner thus seeks withdrawal of the present petition.

Disposed of as withdrawn at this stage.
