The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take legal action on the representation dated 02.07.2021 (Annexure P/4) moved by the petitioner and register the case as per law.

Status report by way of affidavit of Lakhwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Crime Against Women and Children, Moga on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh submits that the dispute between petitioner and respondent No.5 is a matrimonial dispute. During the course of inquiry, it has emerged that the respondent No.5 has instituted a petition against the petitioner under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for dissolution of marriage and the petitioner has also instituted a petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for restitution of conjugal rights. Both the parties had stated that they intend to get their respective cases decided by the Court. Consequently, after completion of the inquiry, the application of the petitioner has been consigned to Record Room.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
