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SANJIV BERRY, J.

By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr. P.C., the petitioner seeks direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to consider and take action on the representation dated 09.01.2023 (Annexure P-3), moved to respondent No. 3.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is 79 years old person and is not able to move. However, respondents No. 5 to 9 have got one document (Annexure P-1), i.e. the sale deed dated 13.09.2022, allegedly executed on his behalf claiming Rs. 70 lakh as sale consideration which is factually wrong.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner has moved a representation dated 09.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No. 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No. 5

to 9 but till date no action has been taken on the said representation. Hence, the present petition.

4. It is further contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that, for the purpose of present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if respondent No. 3 is directed to take appropriate legal action in accordance with law while considering and disposing of the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-3) in an expeditious manner.

5. Heard.

6. Notice of motion.

7. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

8. Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances and without commending on the merits thereof, the petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-Superintendent of Police, Nuh, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 09.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) and to dispose of the same expeditiously in accordance with the law.

9. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
