1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to transfer the investigation of case FIR No.347 dated 20.08.2022 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506, 341, 427 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Tauru, District Nuh to Crime Branch, Faridabad, and get conducted the investigation of the present case from any higher official not below the rank of Superintendent of Police as till date no accused has been arrested.
2. Earlier the petitioner had filed CRM-M-48268 of 2022 – Jamshed v. State of Haryana and others – making same prayer as has been made in the present petition and the said petition was disposed of vide order dated 18.10.2022 with the following directions: -

“In the light of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of

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this order.”

3. Learned State counsel, on receipt of advance copy of the petition, on instructions from ASI Ravinder, submits that the present petition is totally mis-conceived as five accused have already been arrested and the matter is still under investigation.

4. In view of the above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
