The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.11 dated 18.01.2022, registered under Sections 307, 323, 148, 149, 427, 120-B, 188 of IPC and Section 51 of Disaster Management Act, 2005, at Police Station Division No.8, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 12.05.2023 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. Even otherwise, it is apparent from the order dated 12.05.2023 that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 12.05.2023 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
