1. Petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to initiate legal action on the representations dated 18.02.2017 and 11.09.2017 (Annexures P-3 and P-5) against respondent Nos.5 to 14.

2. On 17.04.2023, the following order was passed:-

"Status report by way of affidavit of Gurvinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, (Rural), Rupnagar, District Rupnagar on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that as per the allegations of the petitioner, her father had been abducted and she had submitted a representation dated 11.09.2017 (Annexure P-5) in this regard. It has been submitted that the strenuous efforts were made to locate him but to no effect. The photographs of the father of the petitioner were pasted at conspicuous places of Districts Rupnagar, SAS Nagar, Fatehgarh Sahib, Patiala, Sangrur and SBS Nagar with the remarks that if any information in this regard comes to light, the same may be passed on to the District Police, Rupnagar. Efforts were made to locate him at various religious places and the pamphlets depicting his photograph and complete particulars were also circulated. The record pertaining to unidentified bodies in the police station situated on Sirhind Canal, Bist Canal and Bhakhra Canal, in the area of District Rupnagar, Fatehgarh Sahib, Sangrur and Patiala for the period from 18.02.2017 till date has also been thoroughly examined. The record pertaining to unidentified dead bodies recovered on the railway tracks has also been perused but no clue regarding missing

*Gurdial Singh has come into light. The respondent Nos.4 to 14 were also associated in the enquiry but no clue could be procured from them. The petitioner and his brother, namely, Kulwant Singh have sold their property and presently are not residing at the given address. Even, Gurdial Singh, the father of the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender in the case bearing FIR No.40 dated 29.04.2015, under Sections 323/341/324/326/506/427 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur in terms of order dated 12.05.2017 passed by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rupnagar. Gurdial Singh in order to evade his arrest is absconding and has concealed himself at some undisclosed place.
None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.
In the interest of justice, adjourned to 25.04.2023.
To be shown in the urgent list."*

- 3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner despite pass over.
- 4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
