VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the Division Bench-II of the Financial Commissioner comprising of respondents no.2 and 3 to hear and decide the revision petition i.e., ROR no.473 of 2017-18 dated 02.07.2018 (Annexure P-4) without any further delay.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has highlighted the zimni orders, which have been reproduced at pages 12 and 13 of the writ petition, to show that the case was last listed on 30.04.2019 and thereafter the same has not been listed till date. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would be satisfied in case Division Bench-II of the Financial Commissioner is directed to decide the same expeditiously in a time bound manner.

3. Learned State counsel has stated that every endeavour would be made by Division Bench-II of the Financial Commissioner to decide the revision petition within a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.
4. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Division Bench-II of the Financial Commissioner comprising of respondents no.2 and 3 to hear and decide the revision petition i.e., ROR no.473 of 2017-18 dated 02.07.2018 within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.
5. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and Division Bench-II of the Financial Commissioner would consider the revision petition independently, in accordance with law.
