Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India by the petitioner seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondent to confirm the service of the petitioner on fixed salary in the light of Resolution No. 846 dated 01.11.2007 Annexure P-6 and Resolution No. 564 dated 01.07.2008 Annexure P-7 passed by the Executive Committee for SGPC granting the benefit of confirmation in service on fixed salary to the employees who have rendered three years of service on temporary/daily wage basis.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who had already rendered more than 20 years of service to the Gurdwara, was appointed on temporary basis as Sewadar by the SGPC. He submits that as per Resolution No. 846 dated 01.11.2007 and Resolution No. 567 dated

01.07.2005 of the Executive committee of SGPC, an employee who has rendered more than 3 years of service on temporary or daily wage basis, is entitled to be confirmed in service on fixed salary. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 26.02.2023 (Annexure P-15), which is still pending consideration with respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record of the case.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the legal notice, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present petition in *limine*. The respondent is directed to decide the legal notice dated 26.02.2023 (Annexure P-15), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
