The petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 to 14 for causing death of her husband and further to decide the complaint dated 31.05.2021 filed by the petitioner to respondents No.2 and 3.

Notice was issued and the State was directed to file status report.

Status report by way of affidavit of Sarwan Singh Bal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala has already been filed. It has been contended by learned State counsel that the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner in the present petition are without any basis. He submits that husband of the petitioner was suffering from Asthma and he died due to his ill health. He submits that after filing of complaints and the representations, the parties were called by the Investigating Agency, wherein, the petitioner made a statement that she does not want to pursue the representation. It is also submitted that it is specifically mentioned in the status report that enquiry was conducted in representation dated 12.07.2021 and 18.08.2021 and as per the enquiry report dated 14.10.2021, it was found that dispute between the parties is of civil nature and

the same is regarding the share of the property.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel and the status report, it is apparent that the allegations made by the petitioner were enquired into, however, the same were not substantiated. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to pursue her alternative remedy in accordance with law.
