Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to sanction the child care leave to the petitioner for 182 days out of the balance due leave of 332 days.

State counsel has placed on record a copy of order dated 27.08.2021 to submit that sanction has been accorded to extend the child care leave to the petitioner from 22.06.2021 to 29.08.2021, i.e. the date when her child attains the age of 18 years.

Faced with this development, counsel for the petitioner submits that instant petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
