1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to shift the car bazaar from Chotti Baradari, Patiala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for the grievances raised in the present petition, the petitioner has given a legal notice dated 13.03.2023 to the respondents including respondent no.2- Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Patiala and the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to consider the said legal notice within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the present order and in case merit is found in the same, then appropriate action be taken, in accordance with law.

3. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to look

the receipt of certified copy of the present order and in case merit is found in the plea raised by the petitioner, then appropriate action be taken, in accordance with law after hearing all the stakeholders in the present case.
