In substance, the dispute is with regard to the genuineness of the disability certificate submitted by the petitioner to claim extension in the period of service after attaining the normal age of 58 years.

On account of the pendency of a writ petition in the High Court, the Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, has directed the petitioner to get his permanent physical impairment re-assessed from the Civil Surgeon, Amritsar.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the Medical Board has already assessed the petitioner's disability vide Annexure P-1.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that the authenticity of this document is in doubt.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no objection, if his disability is once again re-assessed, however, it should not be a never ending process.

Learned State counsel submits that the necessary instructions will be issued to the Civil Surgeon, Amritsar, to constitute a Board of competent Doctors to re-assess the petitioner’s disability, if any, within a period of one week, from today.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no further order is required to be passed.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
