The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing transfer order dated 24.07.2020 (Annexure P-5), vide which the petitioner herein has been transferred from Panchkula to Kalanwali, Sirsa.

Initially, impugned order was stayed on 10.08.2020 by this Court, which subsequently, came to be vacated by passing a detailed order dated 08.09.2020. The matter was then adjourned on two separate occasions on the request of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

On the last date of hearing, no one put in an appearance on behalf of the petitioner and the matter stood adjourned for 09.08.2021 and, thereafter,

the matter has been taken up for hearing today for the first time.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 would submit that the petitioner herein has already joined at the place where he stood transferred i.e. at Kalanwali, Sirsa.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today in a petition seeking to challenge the transfer order. It seems that the petitioner is no longer interested in pursuing with the instant matter.

Consequently, the instant writ petition is dismissed in default, leaving it open to the petitioner to revive the same, in case any grievance still survived.
