Prayer in the present third petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.102 dated 27.04.2021, under Section 304-B, 34 of IPC (Section 498-A IPC and Sections 3, 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 added later on), at Police Station City Pehowa, District Kurukshetra.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is behind bars since 28.04.2021 and the material witnesses have not supported the case of the prosecution. However, learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Raj Kumar, has submitted that out of 29 prosecution witnesses, only 02 witnesses remain to be examined and the case is fixed before the trial Court for 03.06.2023 for examination of the witnesses.

Keeping in view the stage of trial, this Court does not find it appropriate to go into the merits of the case. However, the petition is disposed of with direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial

expeditiously. The prosecution would not prolong the trial unnecessarily.
In case the prosecution is not able to conclude its evidence on 03.06.2023
i.e. the date fixed, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek his remedies
as available to him under law.
