VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to enter and sanction the mutations regarding properties left by late Sh. Manjit Singh Toor son of Joginder Singh, resident of Village Jawaddi, Ludhiana, who died intestate on 21.01.2021 in favour of the petitioner and other legal heirs of Manjit Singh Toor.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate applications before the concerned Assistant Collector, IInd Grade. He has further submitted that in case, any such application is filed, then the Assistant Collector, IInd Grade be directed to decide the same

as expeditiously as possible.

3. Learned State Counsel has submitted that in case, any such application is moved before the concerned Assistant Collector, IInd Grade, then the Assistant Collector, IInd Grade, would decide the same, as expeditiously as possible.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

5. In case, any such application is filed by the petitioner before the concerned Assistant Collector, IInd Grade, then the Assistant Collector, IInd Grade is directed to consider and decide the same, as expeditiously as possible.

6. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and it would be open to the Assistant Collector, IInd Grade to decide the application independently and in accordance with law.
