There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

However, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh submits that the petitioner has already been granted the concession of regular bail vide order dated 06.07.2023 by the Court of Shri Baljinder Singh, Special Judge, Sangrur holding that on the basis of FSL report, salt found in the recovered Narcotic Substance does not fall within the category of NDPS Act, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. Probably that is the reason, counsel for the petitioner petitioner is not appearing before this Court.

In the light of the above, petition stands disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

However it is made clear that if still any grievance is left with the petitioner qua seeking regular bail in the FIR in question. He will be at liberty to file necessary application, if so advised.
