1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.71 dated 08.03.2023 registered under Sections 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 325 and 308 IPC added later on, at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.
2. Vide order dated 11.05.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 11.05.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.05.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
