VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.5 to cooperate with the petitioner Gram Panchayat to get complete all the development works in the Village as per Resolution dated 16.12.2022 (Annexure P-10).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that with respect to the grievances raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition, the petitioner had given a representation dated 23.02.2023 (Annexure P-13) to respondent No.3-ADC (Development), Amritsar and further submits that he would be satisfied in case, respondent No.3 considers the said representation in a time bound manner and in case, merit is found in the plea

raised by the petitioner, then prays that necessary relief be granted as expeditiously as possible.

3. Learned State Counsel has submitted that every endeavour would be made by respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 23.02.2023 (Annexure P-13) within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order and in case, respondent No.3 finds merits in the same, then the necessary amount would be released as expeditiously as possible.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- ADC (Development), Amritsar to consider representation dated 23.02.2023 (Annexure P-13) within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order and in case, respondent No.3 finds merits in the same, then the necessary amount would be released as expeditiously as possible.

5. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.3 would decide the same independently, in accordance with law.
