The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the cross version arising out of FIR No. 195 dated 26.11.2012 under Sections 307, 323,324, 341,148,149 of IPC registered at Police Station Shahkot District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom and further quashing of order dated 01.09.2014 (Annexure P-5).

Learned State counsel submits that petitioners No.1,2,5,6 and 7 have been declared to be proclaimed offenders.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage, with liberty to file a fresh petition after the abovesaid petitioners surrender before the competent Court of law.

In case, petitioners No.1,2,5,6 and 7 surrender before the Trial Court/Area Magistrate, their bail applications shall be considered sympathetically by the concerned Court in view of the fact that the parties have entered into a compromise.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid.
