Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C. seeking setting aside/quashing of PO order dated 05.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Gidderbaha, in complaint bearing No. NACT/332/2016 under Section 138 of the N.I. Act, instituted on 22.12.2016 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the order dated 06.06.2023, passed by Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Gidderbaha, in case titled as '*Rajesh Kumar vs. Neeraj Kumar Singla*', in *CIS No. NACT/332/2016*, which is marked as Annexure AX, to submit that in compliance to the order dated 02.06.2023, the petitioner has surrendered in the trial Court and has furnished the requisite bail bonds.
