AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This revision petition is filed seeking quashing of order dated 20th April, 2023 whereby the request of the petitioner to decide the preliminary issue with regard to the maintainability of arbitration vis-a-vis one of the claim was declined and ordered to be decided along with the main matter.
2. The surviving grievance of the petitioner is that if the issue of lease deed being non-arbitrable is accepted, the claimed amount will drastically come down. If the issue is not decided at first instance, the petitioner will have to shell out the arbitrator fee on the full amount.
3. After arguing for some time and realising that no request was made before the arbitrator for either tentatively deciding the fee or for postponing the decision of fee, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for including approaching the arbitrator.
5. Since the main case is dismissed as withdrawn, pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
