Present petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 19.8.2010 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Court of ACJM, Jalandhar whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender/proclaimed person in a case having FIR No.112 dated 6.5.2009 registered under Sections 420 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

In the present case, notice of motion order was passed on 30.11.2017 and in the meantime, further proceedings before the learned trial Court were stayed.

Vide impugned order dated 18.11.2022, clarification was sought from the counsel for the petitioner as to whether after the passing of interim order dated 30.11.2017, the petitioner ever applied for grant of bail and as to whether, she is regularly appearing before the learned trial Court in the concerned criminal case and in this regard, report was also called

from the Court concerned. As per report submitted by the learned trial Court, the petitioner never appeared before the said Court during the proceedings of the aforesaid criminal case.

Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner made submission that he is unable to contact the petitioner for the last 10 days.

In view of above, it appears that the petitioner is not interested in prosecution of the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed for want of prosecution. Interim order, if any, stands vacated.
