Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.230 dated 03.04.2023 registered under Sections 174-A IPC at Police Station Hansi City, District Hisar.

The counsel for the petitioner, *inter-alia*, contends that the present petition is offshoot of *Criminal Complaint No.NACT-186-2020* titled as “Sandeep Soni Vs. Ajay Soni” wherein earlier the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person but later on the petitioner surrendered and has been granted regular bail in the said criminal complaint vide order of learned trial Court dated 25.04.2023 (Annexure P-3). The counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is ready to join the investigation with the police in the present case being FIR No.230 dated 03.04.2023 registered under Sections 174-A IPC at Police Station Hansi City, District Hisar.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Naveen Kumar Sheoran, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that as petitioner has been granted regular bail by the trial Court

in the main case vide Annexure P-3, the petitioner may be directed to join the investigation with the Police in the aforesaid FIR.

In the light of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to appear before the trial Court within next 20 days and on his appearance, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction.

The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
