Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner, her husband Hardeep Singh, her brother-in-law Kuldeep Singh, her mother-in-law Gopal Kaur and Amandeep Singh, minor son of the petitioner had no concern with the

said incident nor they were trying to help the named accused i.e. Prem Singh. Still, the local police was harassing them and was raiding their house.

3. On advance notice, Mr. Amish Sharma, AAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the petitioner and her above named family members are not required during the course of investigation. He has further assured the Court that the investigation in case FIR No.184, dated 20.12.2022, under Sections 302, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur shall be conducted fairly and impartially. He further submits that in case, the petitioner or any of her family members are required to join the investigation, an advance written notice shall be issued to them and they shall not be harassed illegally.

4. Needless to say that the police is free to conduct the investigation as per the procedure established by law. In case, the involvement of any person is found during the course of investigation, the police is at liberty to take steps in accordance with law.

5. With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
