The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for seeking reinvestigation by an independent agency in case bearing FIR No. 131 dated 31.05.2021 registered under Sections 353, 186, 332, 188, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 at Police Station Kotwali, Nabha (Annexure P-1).

It has been pointed out by the State Counsel that CRM-M-6740-2022 was also filed by the petitioner for the same cause of action which was disposed of as not maintainable and liberty was granted to the petitioner to file an appropriate application seeking reinvestigation and/or additional charges “before the trial Court”.

Notwithstanding the aforesaid order, the present petition has been filed.

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Faced with the above, counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the instant writ present petition to seek clarification and/or liberties from the Court where the Criminal Miscellaneous petition had been filed.

Disposed of as withdrawn at this stage with liberty as aforesaid.
