1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.104 dated 12.07.2016, registered for offences under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 30.04.2022, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties. Prayer has also been made for setting aside order dated 04.03.2021, Annexure P-7, whereby petitioner No.3 has been declared as a Proclaimed Person.
2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner No.3 has not been declared as a proclaimed person/offender in the present proceedings. He submits that impugned order, Annexure P-7, actually pertains to some other criminal case against petitioner No.3.
3. On the basis of prayer made in the application (CRM-35425-2023), which is supported with an affidavit of the petitioner No.2, counsel for the petitioners seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
