1. This petition is filed for quashing of the order dated 28.10.2017 whereby the order of discharge passed in favour of the petitioner by the Trial Court was set aside.

2. On 3.7.2023, the following order was passed :-

“Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the petitioner has not been appearing before the trial Court, after the order of discharge was set aside by Revisional Court, consequent to which, during the pendency of this petition, she was declared proclaimed person vide order dated 26.02.2018.

There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 25.01.2023. The position remains the same even today.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 20.07.2023

Date be notified to the petitioner as also her counsel.”

3. Thereafter, on 20.7.2023, Mr. Kushagra Beniwal, Advocate appeared on behalf of the petitioner through Memo of Appearance. On

8.8.2023, he did not file Power of Attorney and sought time. Today, the petitioner is unrepresented.

4. The petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
5. Since the main case has been dismissed for non-prosecution the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
